What a remarkable year it has been so far; with COVID-19 and the generosity of our supporters! Kadzinuni is a rural community with just the clinic we built providing basic primary healthcare and health education. The nearest hospital being in Kilifi, several hours walk away. So, in May in the face of Covid-19 approaching the village we acted quickly to **PROTECT Kadzinuni**. By initially dipping into our modest reserves we funded the purchase of masks, tapped buckets for handwashing, soap, gel and food supplies for the families in most hardship including the disabled and children with special needs. Like here the schools closed and a strict travel ban was imposed. By late June our special appeal had raised just short of £4,000 which was sent out and spent within days in phases from May to July on the items listed above. The best news of all is that at the time of writing **there have been no confirmed cases of Covid-19 at Kadzinuni**. We will continue to be vigilant and within our modest means do all we can to keep this awful disease out of Kadzinuni.
